| <b>A3</b>             | Conduct and Conviction of a licensed Private Hire / Hackney Carriage (Joint) Driver | <p>(a) That the applicant was a fit and proper person to hold a Private Hire/Hackney Carriage Driver's Licence under the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976 and that the Licence be granted; under the strict condition that the applicant receive quarterly update reports from his GP and that he request that his GP refer him for a psychiatrist test.</p>       |
