A2	Local Government (Access to Information) Act 1985 - To consider the exclusion of the press and public	<p><u>RESOLVED:</u></p> <p>That the press and public be excluded from the meeting for the following item as this was considered to contain exempt information by virtue of paragraphs 12 and 13 of Part 4 of Schedule 12A of the Local Government Act 1972 (as amended).</p>
A3	Application for a Personal Licence	<p><u>RESOLVED:</u></p> <p>That the application be refused as the applicant was not considered to be a fit and proper person to hold a Personal Licence as defined within the Licensing Act 2003 for the following reasons:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • drink driving was a relevant conviction and the Rehabilitation period had not expired; • whilst the Applicant showed genuine remorse and was open and honest about the circumstances of the offence the Sub-Committee considered it to be both serious and recent, having been committed in November 2021; • the Sub-Committee took into account the submissions of North Wales Police that granting the Application would undermine the crime prevention objective and did not consider that the Applicant had sufficiently demonstrated otherwise; • given the above, the Sub-Committee was of the view that the Crime Prevention Objective would be undermined if the licence was granted.
