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



Wales & West Housing

Invest – making homes warm and affordable

- £5.3 million investment to achieve WHQS compliance
- Majority local contractors and employment
- £1.4 million on energy efficiency average SAP rating of 73 (WHQS requirement of 65)
 - 84% of homes insulated
- Renewed components in 92% of Flintshire stock
- New property designs

Technology – making the most of

- Free WiFi where ever possible
 - Over 60 schemes
 - 500 regular users Llys Jasmine
 - Take CTRL digi-users to support other residents
- Connect24 telecare and out of hours
 - 9,000 residents supported across Wales with emergency alarm and telecare
 - 70,000 households for out of hours repairs and ASB



Care and Support - new services

- Dementia/disability friendly culture
- Upgrade to schemes access, signage, colours, gardens, buggy storage
- Direct provider of support first scheme in Abergele
- Direct provider of Care registration with Care and social Services Inspectorate Wales (CSSIW)



GROW – generating real opportunities for work

- Specialist team to work with residents
 - Employment coaching
 - Training assessment and sourcing
- Through development and major works contracts
 - 17 apprenticeships created
 - 5,000 hours of training provided
 - 80% of workforce from Flintshire and North Wales

Lives – supporting residents

- Housing Options team (in 2013/14 69% of lets offered to Flintshire – 30% to homeless)
 - Actively working with FCC on SARTH
 - Early engagement with prospective tenants support needs, financial advice, furniture, etc
- Starting right rent collection
 - Sustainable, affordable payment plans
 - Seven strong specialist money advice team gained on average £780 per resident
 - Minimised impact of bedroom tax 85% collection
