## **REPORT DETAILS**

<b>1.00</b>	<b>EXPLAINING THE APPLICATION</b>
1.01	The premises concerned is the Mold Alex Clubhouse, Alyn Park, Denbigh Road, Mold, CH7 1BP. Its location can be seen in Appendix A.
1.02	The applicant is Mold Alex Football Club whose Chairman is Mr Wayne Emberton.
1.03	The application is to vary an existing Premises Licence which has been held by Mold Alex Football Club since August 2016.
1.04	The applicant has applied to vary the following licensable activities: Plays, Films, Indoor Sporting Events, Live and Recorded Music and anything of a similar description, late night refreshment and the supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises.
1.05	For the above activities the Licence currently operates to the following hours:  Monday to Thursdays 13:00 to 23:00 Friday and Saturday 11:00 to 23:00 Sunday 11:00 to 17:00
1.06	The hours applied for are as follows:  Monday to Thursdays 09:00 to 23:00 Friday and Saturday 09:00 to 00:00 Sunday 09:00 to 21:00
1.07	Representations have been received from a number of local residents. These can be seen in Appendix B.
1.08	North Wales Fire and Rescue Service have confirmed in writing that they will not be making any representations to the Licensing Authority regarding the application.
1.09	North Wales Police have confirmed in writing that the application has been discussed with Inspector Jon Bowcott, the officer responsible for the area, and that they make no representations to this application.
1.10	Flintshire County Council's Pollution Control Section have not made representations.
1.11	The steps that the applicant intends to take to promote the four licensing objectives are set out in Appendix C
1.12	The application was advertised in the correct manner.

<b>7.00</b>	<b>GLOSSARY OF TERMS</b>
7.01	<b>Licensing Act 2003</b> – referred to as the Act.  <b>Premises Licence</b> – means a licence granted under the Act, in respect of any premises, which authorises the premises to be used for one or more licensable activities.  <b>Time limited</b> – its duration is limited to a set date(s) and time(s).  <b>Licensable activities</b> – these are the sale by retail of alcohol, the supply of alcohol by or on behalf of a club to, or on the order of, a member of the club, the provision of regulated entertainment, and the provision of late night refreshment.

**Regulated entertainment** - is defined as a performance of a play, an exhibition of a film, an indoor sporting event, a boxing or wrestling entertainment (both indoors and outdoors), a performance of live music, any playing of recorded music, or a performance of dance

**Late night refreshment** – a person provides late night refreshment if at any time between the hours of 11.00pm and 5.00am., he supplies hot food or hot drink to members of the public, or a section of the public, on or from any premises, whether for consumption on or off the premises.

**Supply of alcohol** – means the sale by retail of alcohol, or the supply of alcohol by or on behalf of a club to, or to the order of, a member of the club.

**Licensing Objectives** - the Act sets out four licensing objectives. These are the prevention of crime and disorder, public safety, prevention of public nuisance, and the protection of children from harm.
