
Who we are?





425 Tonnes of waste plastic contaminated with mixed waste, stored without a permit or exemption.


Non-compliance with two enforcement notices to remove the waste from site.







- 1) Fires on 9th March & 1st May

- 5) NRW visiting regularly























- Environment Officers respond to incidents 24/7 365 days a year. It is the most important part of our role.
- In total 8469 incident are reported annually av 23 per day
- 5748 of these are within NRW remit
- 2923 substantiated av 8 per day
