SUBJECT: THE NORTH EAST WALES FOOD WASTE

TREATMENT PROJECT

**RECOMMENDATIONS OF REPORT:** It is recommended that Members:-

- a) Approve the removal of TEG Environmental as Preferred Bidder to the NE HUB Food Waste project, should they fail to secure funding by the deadline date of 30th March 2012.
- b) Approve the selection of Reserve Bidder, BiogenGreenfinch, to be awarded Preferred Bidder status, should TEG Environmental fail to secure funding by the deadline date.
- c) Grant delegated authority to the Head of Legal & Democratic Services to finalise all necessary contractual documentation associated with the contract, in conjunction with Denbighshire, as lead authority, and Conwy Councils and to sign the contract, together with the Chair of the Council.

## **FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS:**

In order to satisfy EU directives, the Welsh Government (WG) has established statutory landfill diversion targets, together with a mechanism for levying fines (on Councils) if the targets are not met, i.e. via Reg 13 of the Landfill Allowances Scheme (Wales) Regulations 2004. WG gave clear guidance to Councils that (in their view) the only feasible way of avoiding Landfill Diversion fines would be to separately collect and recycle food waste.

WG have committed to levels of financial support that amount to 15% of the gate fee costs. This support however is conditional upon Anaerobic Digestion (AD) being the chosen treatment technology. WG's financial incentive (in favour of AD) was taken in account when the final tenders were evaluated.

The solution cost of the Reserve Bidder (BiogenGreenfinch) is well within the 'Affordability Envelope' of £66 per tonne and significantly less than the cost of landfill. The BiogenGreenfinch Band A gate fee is £59.50 (Band 'A' being applied to the tonnage that the project is guaranteeing to supply). For tonnages above the guaranteed supply, BiogenGreenfinch apply a 'Band B' gate fee of £20 per tonne.

Table 1 below sets out a summary of the gate fee and transport costs tendered by both BiogenGreenfinch and TEG Environmental, starting with our current costs for the temporary contract we have with BiogenGreenfinch for treating our food waste at their facility in North Shropshire.

As shown in Table 1, the Council's current temporary contract is £40.00/t plus £17.50/t haulage. However, this is a rolling contract with no guarantee of price going forward. Over the next 15 years, there will be increasing demands placed on the need to recycle food waste, particularly that produced by the commercial sector (restaurants, hotels, etc) and hence the capacity of suitable facilities is likely to be scarce, thereby driving up treatment prices. Hence it is considered that the BiogenGreenfinch treatment price per tonne offers the Council value for money when considered over the 15 year term of the contract, as it will only change to reflect inflationary costs under an agreed indexation formula.

For Flintshire County Council, there is a difference of £62,040 pa, based on our

guarantee minimum tonnage of 5,500t pa, between the BiogenGreenfinch Band A charge and the TEG Environmental final charge. If Flintshire were to supply over the guaranteed tonnage, for example 6,500 tonnes, the BiogenGreenfinch Band B rate of £20 per tonne would be applied to 1000 tonnes so that the difference between TEG Environmental and BiogenGreenfinch costs in this scenario would amount to £33,820 pa.

Should Members approve the recommendations, the Partnership will talk to Biogengreenfinch about their proposed interim costs (ie following contract award and up to the new facility opening) with a view to reducing them.

The 15% WG Revenue support for the gate fee is guaranteed over the contract period of (15 years) at WG approval of the Final Business Case.

**CONSULTATION UNDERTAKEN:** The consultation has been actively

opened up to individuals, councillors, community and voluntary groups, CF staff and Partnership Boards, public and 3rd sector partners with local, strategic and regional interests. A variety of methods have been employed since July 2011, involving email, face to face, briefing notes, partners meetings and events, in addition to local Partnership Board

activities.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS: The CF programme is currently wholly

WG funded and the investment in 2011/12 in Flintshire is likely to be about £800,000. While revised proposals will

address the need for efficiencies, no

specific savings have been demanded. Nonetheless, it will be necessary to show in any future bid, partner commitment to programme bending, where resources are shared or pooled.

The Communities First bid will, within the constraints of the grant funding requirements, aim to retain the existing level of funding as far as possible, but will target resources more effectively for greater impact.

CF Flintshire programme expenditure between April 2009 - September 2012 amounts to £2.04m. The new phase offers potential for approximately a further £2m over 3.5 years if a full two cluster bid is successful.

As a potential Lead Delivery Body, Flintshire County Council needs to be aware that CF programme funding will in future be paid in arrears, not in advance. Payments under the Transitional arrangements will continue to be paid in advance under the existing grant conditions until 30th September 2012.
