In terms of the budget the current budget and contributions of each of the authorities can be seen in the Legal Agreement. Over the next five years the budget will become, by negotiation, equitable between the three authorities. Flintshire currently contributes £26,500 plus officer time towards the Joint Advisory Committee. The draft legal opinion supposes that this will increase over five years to £42,136 which would be considerably more than the current spend. The principle of making an increased contribution in accordance with the methodology shown in the draft agreement is not accepted at this stage. as the geographical area within Flintshire has remained the same. It is recommended that in a time of general reductions in spending, the Joint Committee be asked to keep the overall cost, and therefore the contribution made by Flintshire, to the minimum necessary for the effective working of the Committee.

one site only. If working collaboratively,

the funding model will need to

demonstrate that St. Richard Gwyn with the larger provision is not providing a hidden subsidy for the smaller provision at

Flint High School.
