priorities. The Corporate Resources Overview and Scrutiny Committee have also been consulted around the development of the draft Plan.

Feedback from the PSB partners' governing bodies has also been taken into account in the final drafting of the Plan.

Detailed feedback from the Future Generations Commissioner for Wales and Welsh Government has also been provided.
