A5	Sharing Information within the Council	<p>(a) That a working group be established to re-write the rules for officers and Members contained within the Constitution on how information is shared inside the Council;</p> <p>(b) That the working group should consist of up to 8 members including the Chair or Vice Chair of the Committee, Cabinet Members for Education, Housing and Social Services (whose portfolios handle the most sensitive personal data) plus 1 member from each of the other political groups; and</p> <p>(c) That the working group be asked to report to the Constitution and Democratic Services Committee in time for it to make recommendations to the Annual Meeting of Council in May 2018.</p>
A6	Overview & Scrutiny Annual Report	<p>(a) That the suggested foreword be included in the Annual Report; and</p> <p>(b) That, subject to the amendments put forward by Councillors Bithell and Peers, the Committee approves the report for submission to Council at the next meeting.</p>
