A3	Application for a Private Hire / Hackney Carriage (Joint) Driver Licence	<p>After carefully considering all the relevant information, the Sub-Committee has determined that the applicant should be granted a Private Hire / Hackney Carriage (Joint) driver's licence for a period of three years, on condition that a further enhanced DBS is carried out after 12 months at the expense of the applicant.</p> <p>In coming to this decision, the Sub-Committee had regard to the seriousness of the offence, but also the explanation provided by the applicant, the disposal of it by way of a caution and the considerable amount of time that has passed since the events and the applicant's evidence of good character thereafter.</p> <p>On balance, the Sub-Committee is satisfied that the applicant is a fit and proper person within the meaning of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976.</p>
