- The Store which is coming to Morris Garage is making an application for an "off licence - bar - 11 pm. There was a notice on the fence about it, dated January 9th and have 28 days to protest. I am protesting on the following
- ① This is a residential, built-up area plenty of houses. Next to this Store is a Block of Pensioners Flats. There are 80yrs and 90yrs^{old} residents here - I am here, I am 80yrs. old. There will be a noise problem late at night - pensioners want quietness at this time of their life. The Flats have had trouble with cans etc., and food and packaging and knocking on my window.
 - ② There are two Senior Schools in the area - ~~one~~ only a few yards from the Stores. Children will pass here to and from school every day - there are 18yrs. old pupils in the 6th Forms - so they can buy alcohol and give to youngsters. Parents are concerned about this.
 - ③ A few yards away a Convenience Store + Off licence has just opened - not a good idea to have two

"off licenced" within a few yards of each other, and a
Block of Pensioners Flats between them.

to the above items.
