"The Education and Youth Overview and Scrutiny Committee at its recent meeting recognised some of the concerns which the local community had voiced during the conversation - notably transition plans for individual pupils, particularly those in the lead up to GCSE examinations, and transport to and from alternative schools and its cost. Whilst we note that Cabinet has considered these concerns in passing its resolution we request more detail and assurance. Given local rumour over the future of the John Summers High School site, we ask for an assurance that there is no plan in place for its future disposal and, should the school be closed, for a commitment that there would be an open public consultation on the future options for the site including public open space."
