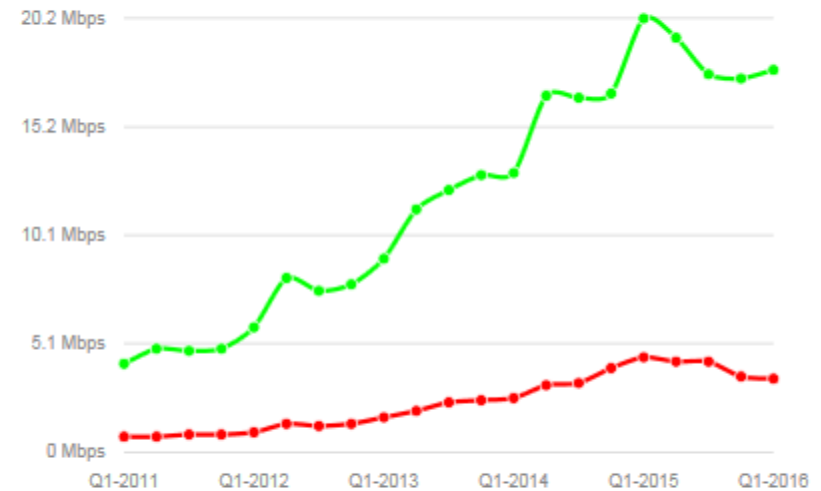

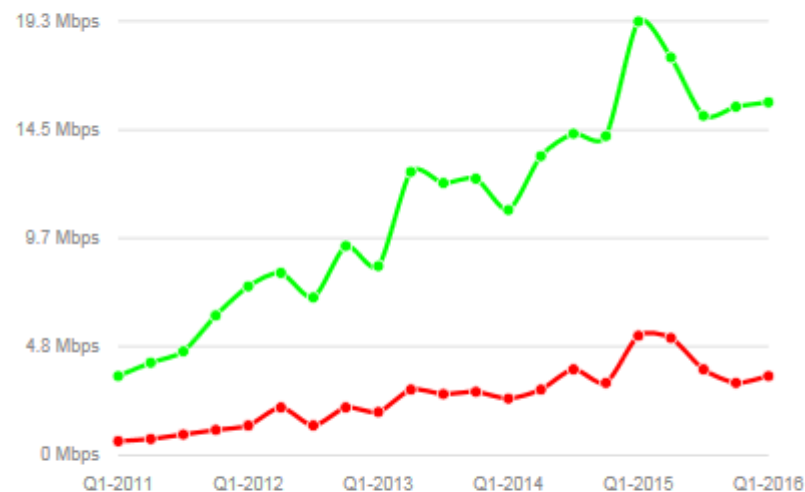

And What About Those Not Covered By Superfast Cymru

- Welsh Government's Access Broadband Cymru
 - Grants of £400 and £800 available to individuals and businesses to obtain 10mb and 30mb broadband through satellite for example

- Welsh Government's Ultrafast Scheme
 - Grants of up to £10,000 available for businesses to obtain 100mb connections through leased lines for example

- BT Community Fibre
 - BT will work with communities and co-invest in order to bring fibre broadband to those missed out by Superfast Cymru

New Residential Developments

- BT is prepared to bring fibre broadband to all new residential developments
- Requires the developer to work with BT in good time
- Many housing developments will receive fibre broadband free of charge
- A co-investment model will work for smaller developments
- This announcement helps drive BT & Welsh Government's shared ambition of increased superfast broadband coverage
