EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

For Members to consider and determine an application under the Licensing Act 2003 for a Premises Licence, in respect of Thrifty's, 7 Broughton Hall Road, Broughton, Flintshire, CH4 0QR.

1.00	EXPLAINING THE APPLICATION
1.01	The premises concerned is 7 Broughton Hall Road, Broughton, Flintshire, CH4 0QR. Its location can be seen in Appendix A.
1.02	The applicant is Cheshire Retail NW Ltd.
1.03	The application is for a Premises Licence for Thrifty's, 7 Broughton Hall Road, Broughton.
1.04	The applicant has applied for the following licensable activities: Supply of alcohol for consumption off the premises.
1.05	The hours applied for are Monday to Sunday 07:00 to 22:00 hours.
1.06	Representations have been received from Mr Mark Griffiths together with a petition from members of the local community in support of his letter, and these can be seen in Appendix B and C respectively.
1.07	Representations have also been received from Mrs Marian Griffiths who lives locally, and these can be seen in Appendix D.
1.08	North Wales Police have confirmed in writing that the application has been discussed with Acting Inspector Geraint Richards, the Officer responsible for the area, and that they make no objections to this application.
1.09	North Wales Fire and Rescue Service have confirmed in writing that they will not be making any representations to the Licensing Authority regarding the application.
1.10	The steps that the applicant intends to take to promote the four licensing objectives are set out in Appendix E.
1.11	The application was advertised in the correct manner.

7.00	GLOSSARY OF TERMS
7.01	Licensing Act 2003 – referred to as the Act.
	Premises Licence – means a licence granted under the Act, in respect of any premises, which authorises the premises to be used for one or more licensable activities.
	Licensable activities – these are the sale by retail of alcohol, the supply of alcohol by or on behalf of a club to, or o the order of, a member of the club, the provision of regulated entertainment, and the provision of late night refreshment.
	Supply of alcohol – means the sale by retail of alcohol, or the supply of alcohol by or on behalf of a club to, or to the order of, a member of the club.
	Licensing Objectives - the Act sets out four licensing objectives. These are the prevention of crime and disorder, public safety, prevention of public nuisance, and the protection of children from harm.
