



# NORTH WALES REGIONAL PLAN

- ❑ Identifies a range of actions in 11 priority areas
- ❑ Lead agencies have been identified for each area
- ❑ Leads are identified across agencies including Health, Local authorities, 3<sup>rd</sup> sector and others
- ❑ The Plan provides scope for regional approaches with local flexibility for delivery
- ❑ Examples of the actions that have been identified include:



## Children and young people

- » Prevention and mitigation of Adverse Childhood Experiences – delivering trauma informed services
- » Review of crisis intervention for children and young people who are experiencing an urgent perceived mental health crisis



## Older people

- » Integration of services for older people with complex needs and long term conditions, including dementia
- » Maintain a sustainable provider market across North Wales



## Health, physical disability and sensory impairments

- » Develop primary care and community resources to provide quicker access and more holistic services
- » Provide support for people with chronic conditions



# Learning disabilities

- » Integration of services for people with learning disabilities
- » Support older carers and older people with learning disabilities



# Mental Health and Substance Misuse

- » Develop an integrated mental health strategy
- » Better identification of mental health needs and early intervention



## Carers

- » Integration of services for carers, including young carers
- » Provide sufficient, flexible carer break provision



## **Violence against women, domestic abuse and sexual violence**

- » Develop a North Wales Strategy which ensures compliance with the Violence against Women, Domestic Abuse and Sexual Violence (Wales) Act 2015
- » Monitor domestic abuse trends through the North Wales Safeguarding Children and Adult's Boards and ensure appropriate training for staff





## Secure Estate

- » Support adults with care and support needs in the secure estate within their county boundary
- » Support children and families of offenders



# Veterans

- » Improving support for veterans, serving military personnel and their families across North Wales
- » Veterans' needs for social care; health and well-being; housing; education, skills and employment



# Housing and Homelessness

- » Need for specialist housing
- » Preventing homelessness



## Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD)

- » Develop an Integrated Autism Service for people not eligible for learning disability or mental health services
- » Develop training and awareness raising around ASD
