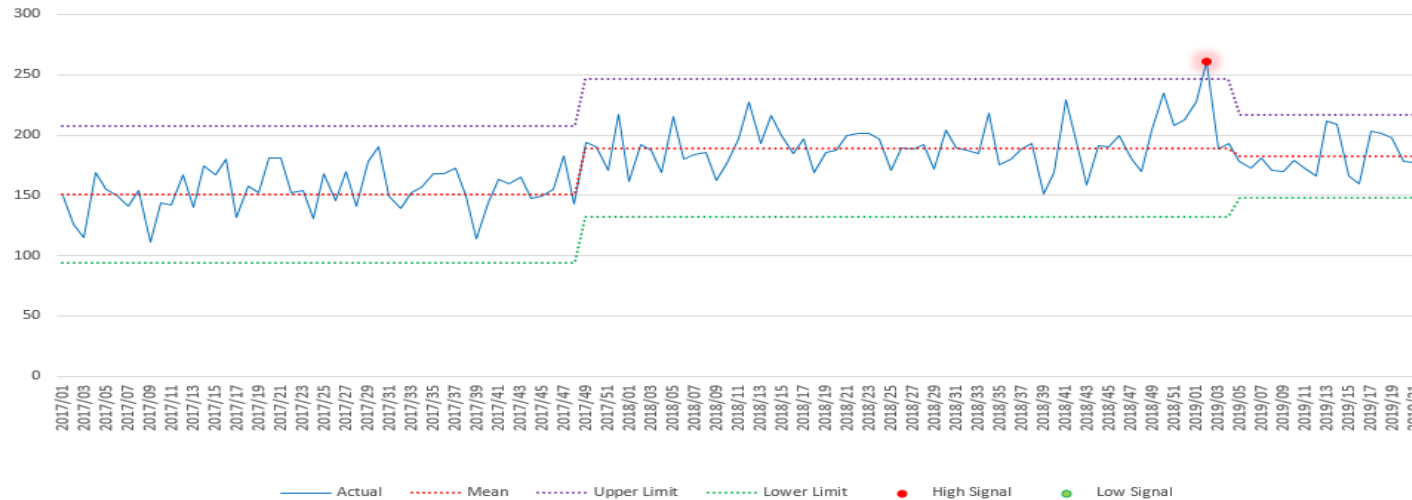

# Performance



- » **Year-to-date figures for 2019/20 show that Victim Based Crime has decreased in Flintshire by -0.5%% in comparison to 2018/19.**
- » **In comparison, North Wales as a whole is currently experiencing a 4.5% year-to-date increase in Victim Based Crime.**
- » **Recorded levels of ASB in Flintshire are lower in 2019/20 when compared to the previous year. This trend has been seen across North Wales, which is currently experiencing a 10.8% year-to-date decrease in ASB.**
