Context...

- » **Continues to be a statutory requirement under Crime and Disorder Act 1998 to have a CSP**
- » **Strategies in place to address:**
 - › Crime and disorder
 - › Substance misuse
 - › Reoffending
- » **Requirement to have a CSP Chair**
- » **Commissioning requirements**
- » **Undertake Domestic Homicide Reviews**
- » **Governance arrangements – delegation to Public Services Board**

Community Safety Delivery Groups

A leaner structure.....

- » **People are Safe Board (Strategic)**
- » **Operational Groups**
 - CDRP Tasking
 - Visible Vulnerable Group
 - Integrated Offender Management Group (IOM)
 - MARAC Task and Finish Groups, e.g. White Ribbon Group
- » **Changing the way we work together, but still making a difference!**

Local priorities for 2020/21

Priority areas

- » **Priority 1: Violence Against Women, Domestic Abuse and Sexual Violence**
- » **Priority 2: Protecting Vulnerable Adults**
- » **Priority 3: Protecting Vulnerable Young People**
- » **Priority 4: Protecting Our Communities**

Crime & Disorder – Current Position

(Position in comparison with previous year)

Increasing Trend

- » Stalking / Harassment + 30.5%
- » Domestic Crime + 15.2%
- » Hate Crime + 11%
- » Anti-Social Behaviour +22.4%
- » Robbery + 3.6% (28 versus 29)

Decreasing Trend

- » Violence with injury -7.2%
- » Sexual offences – 5.8%
- » Burglary residential -34.6%
- » Burglary Business & community - 20%
- » Vehicle Crime – 40.1%
- » Theft and Handling -25.8%
- » Criminal Damage and Arson -11%

Regional Partnerships

- » **Review of Strategic Partnerships**
- » **Continuing to identify common areas where regional approaches are most successful, e.g.**
 - Organised Crime Groups (OCG's)
 - Substance Misuse – relationship with the Area Planning Board
 - Violence Against Women, Domestic Abuse & Sexual Violence
 - Counter terrorism – proportionality
 - Modern Slavery – consistent approach
- » **Making best use of resource, expertise and developing networks**
