Strategic Aims as a Partner Council

- To play a full role in regional recovery planning and implementation
- To fully implement the regional Prevention and Response Plan to protect local communities
- To undertake local surveillance, protection and enforcement activity
- To provide a local trace and protect service
- To enable local access to the vaccination programme
- To enable local access to testing services
- To set-up local mass community testing facilities and services in the event of a local outbreak
- To fully engage with the four themed recovery strategies

Local Surveillance, Protection and Enforcement

- Management of our local Prevention and Surveillance Group
- Monitoring of the local situation and analysis of data and intelligence
- Formation of Incident Management Teams (IMTs) to respond to and control clusters and outbreaks
- Enforcement of Covid-19 regulations and public/employer/trader advice
- Proactive and reactive advice to higher-risk premises and employers

Trace and Protect Service

- Development and review of regional strategy as a partner
- Modelling of the tracing workforce required
- The host employer for the local tracing teams who are devolved for supervision in each of the six local authorities: recruitment to the workforce model in phases; training and induction of recruits
- Budget planning and grant claims via the Health Board
- Full tracing service for positive testing index cases and contacts: advice, support and enforcement for those traced; support for the vulnerable
- Enhanced tracing support and bespoke advice to manage case clusters
- New service to support and advise returned international travellers
- Discretionary service when casework is low e.g. advice to businesses

Vaccination Programme

- Development and review of regional strategy as a partner including demand management and public communications
- Sourcing of a local Mass Vaccination Centre at Deeside Leisure Centre
- Facilities management work to help make the Centre accessible
- Support for the recruitment of vaccinators and volunteer administrators
- Sourcing local residents who qualify for vaccination in cohorts
- Prioritisation of key worker groups for vaccination in order
- Co-leadership of the formation of a new Gold Regional Group for strategy and programme planning
- Work to secure vaccination centres for the autumn/winter booster programme for 2021/22

Testing

- Development and review of a regional strategy as a partner agency
- Identification of centres for permanent test centres for test referrals
- Identification of centres for 'walk-up' local asymptomatic testing e.g. Connah's Quay and Penyffordd
- Promotion of the use of Lateral Flow Testing for schools
- Piloting of Lateral Flow Testing for large work groups e.g. operative groups at Alltami Depot
- Planning for mass community testing in the event of a 'third wave' surge in cases with both walk-up centres and household testing kit drop-off and collection - through the redeployment of employees and the use of local volunteers with FLVC and partners
